As a supplier of drinking water, a water carter must make and keep for at least 6 months records of the following (under section 53 of the Public Health Regulation 2022):

- the name of each supplier of drinking water from which the water carter received water.
- the place, date, time, and volume of water drawn each time from Bellingen Council's supply.
- the name and address of each person to whom the water carter supplies water.
- the place, date, time, and volume of water supplied to that person.
- details of any substances other than drinking water transported in any water tank used by the water carter.
- the dates on which any water tank used by the water carter is cleaned.

Failure to comply with the above requirements will result in significant penalties.
