## Updates and announcements

### February 2018

Roads and Maritime Services is planning to repaint the bridge in 2018. This essential work will protect the bridge from corrosion into the future and reduce ongoing maintenance costs.

To carry out this work safely and efficiently, we are proposing to close the bridge for the duration of the work.

A review of environmental factors (REF) has been prepared to determine the environmental and social impacts of the work.

Raleigh Bridge was opened in 1933, crossing the Bellinger River on Keevers Drive (the Old Pacific Highway) linking the villages of Repton and Raleigh.
